

## Some General Rules / Regulations

- a) All boats, trolleys and trailers must be removed from the club premises during the closed season (Mid-November to 28th February).
- b) For security reasons all road trailers must be removed from SDSC premises or immobilised.
- c) Members may introduce no more than two adult guests in any one day. The same person shall not be introduced on more than four occasions in any one year. Guests cannot sail their own craft, only those registered with the club by a member.
- d) The clubhouse will open only when a designated responsible person is present. At other times the Fishing Lodge should be available for toilet facilities.
- e) Only paid up members may sail in races and have their results counted towards a series.
- f) Effective personal buoyancy must be worn at all times when afloat. Wet suits, dry suits and nappy harnesses do not themselves provide adequate personal buoyancy.
- g) Safety boats must be manned by 2 persons, the helm to be over 16 years of age.
- h) When a flashing amber light is signaled, sailing may continue at own risk .No organised club racing will take place and persons under 16 years MUST leave the water. When 4 lights are shown with a RED LIGHT and repeated sound signals, all boats must leave the water.
- i) Dinghy sailing and windsurfing may be carried out when the club is unmanned, subject to strict 'buddy system' safety regulations.

**NB: The full by-laws and rules of SDSC are contained in the Year Book that is sent to each member. The Year Book also contains organised sailing times which are principally Wednesday and Friday evenings and all day Saturday and Sunday and Bank holidays during the sailing season.**

## MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES & FEES

**The SDSC sailing season is 1st March to mid-November.**

**Membership runs from 1st January to 31<sup>st</sup> December**

Note 1.	BOAT PARK	Note that the Boat Park spaces have to be booked separately to membership
Note 2.	FAMILY	Partners plus children under the age of 18 years on 1st March in the year of membership
Note 3.	SINGLE	Those aged 18 years or over on 1st March and not in receipt of full time education
Note 4.	YOUTH/STUDENT	a) Aged between 16 and 18 years on 1st March or b) Persons in receipt of full time education
Note 5	SAILABILITY	Registered disabled (membership includes carer). Families with at least one disabled sailing member.
Note 6.	JUNIOR	Under 16 yrs on 1st March and not included in a family membership. Must have a parent/guardian present at all times, or have an adult member declared <b>in loco parentis</b> who must be present at all time. This includes consent to medical attention/ treatment being given to a child by an authorised medical practitioner as may appear necessary on taking medical advice.
Note 7.	Non-sailing	Non-sailing, over 18 years of age.
Note 8.	'Distant' Membership	For those living at, or beyond, Sunderland, Durham City, Bishop Auckland, Gainford, Richmond, Leeming, Topcliffe, Raskleff, Helmsley, Malton, and Filey
Note 9.	'Temporary' Membership	Valid for one month. Eg. for those on holiday in the area or taking an introductory course. Boat park extra.
